NEVER:

1. Become involved with a 3rd party middleman or handler in your recruiting process.
2. Attend too many recruiting camps or tryouts.
3. Pay for a recruiting service.
4. Be disrespectful to your coach, your team, your family or on social media posts.
5. Ask about scholarships, playing time, jersey numbers...early in recruiting process.
6. Commit on the visit, or because it is your 1st offer, your only offer, or the college coach is pressuring you to commit.

ALWAYS:

1. Be a leader on your team and play for the right reasons!
2. Be the best student possible (attendance).
3. Stay on top of the NCAA and college recruiting requirements!
4. Have a great mix of plays up-loaded to your 10 minute highlight.
5. Be on your best behavior on a visit as you evaluate the “fit” (geography, campus, academics, staff, players).
6. Choose colleges where your sport is important and where the team competes at the highest level of their division.
